**FREE BUS SERVICE TO FEAST AVAILABLE FROM PURDUE STADIUM  
PARKING LOT**

Lafayette, IN – Visitors to the Feast of the Hunter’s Moon can use a convenient bus service that will leave the Purdue Football Stadium parking lot at the corner of Northwestern Avenue and Cherry Lane in West Lafayette every 15 minutes beginning at 8 a.m. on both Saturday, September 24<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, September 25<sup>th</sup>. Return bus service from the Feast grounds to the Stadium parking lot will be available until 6 p.m. on Saturday and 5 p.m. on Sunday.

The bus service is provided free as a community service by Tippecanoe Evangelical Association of Ministries and Ministers, or TEAMM, a fellowship of area church groups.

“The buses are the most convenient way to reach the Feast,” said Feast Coordinator Leslie Martin Conwell. “The buses deliver guests right to the gate, eliminating parking problems and walking distances.”

Bus service will not be provided from any location other than the Stadium parking lot.
